COUNCIL DECISION (CFSP) 2022/2186

of 8 November 2022

amending Decision (CFSP) 2019/1894 concerning restrictive measures in view of Turkey's unauthorised drilling activities in the Eastern Mediterranean

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty on European Union, and in particular Article 29 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy,

Whereas:

- (1) On 11 November 2019, the Council adopted Decision (CFSP) 2019/1894 (¹) concerning restrictive measures in view of Turkey's unauthorised drilling activities in the Eastern Mediterranean.
- (2) The Council has reviewed the restrictive measures set out in Decision (CFSP) 2019/1894. Based on that review, those measures should be extended until 12 November 2023.
- (3) Decision (CFSP) 2019/1894 should therefore be amended accordingly,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

Article 8 of Decision (CFSP) 2019/1894 is replaced by the following:

'Article 8

This Decision shall apply until 12 November 2023 and shall be kept under constant review. It shall be renewed or amended, as appropriate, if the Council deems that its objectives have not been met.'.

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union.
